ACTIVITY 9

Crafty Crafter:

Paper, glue, yarn, paint – so many things to create! Do a craft together.

Make your own Binoculars!

What you need:

- 2 toilet paper rolls or a paper towel roll cut in half
- Paint or coloured paper
- white glue
- decorations – like stickers, buttons, pom-poms, googly eyes
clothes pegs (to help with drying)

What to do:

1. Paint your rolls or cover them with coloured paper, gluing the paper to the rolls.
2. Add decorations to your two rolls (as many as you like!)
3. Glue one side of one roll and attach it to the outside of the other roll.
4. Clip one clothes peg on each end of your binoculars to hold them together until the glue dries.

Now time to go exploring with your cool new binoculars!
