What can I do on Google Maps?

You can find maps and step-by-step directions to places you want to visit using Google Maps.

Get there: www.google.ca/maps



View a map on your computer, tablet, or smartphone screen that shows your location and the streets near you.



Get directions to where you want to go. You can even learn how long it will take you to get there by walking, biking, driving, or taking public transit.



Find out when the next bus, subway train, or other kind of public transit will leave, and when it will get to the place you want to visit. This service isn't available in all locations.
